GUWAHATI, Jan 28: The Departments of Assamese and Bengali, Gauhati University, and Renaissance Universal (RU), the intellectual forum of Ananda Marga Pracaraka Sangha, Kolkata, are jointly organising the two-day 35th national seminar on Shri Sri Ahammadurjiji's (Shri Prabhat Ranjan Sarkar's) contribution to philosophy, language, literature, music, economics and science at the conference hall, Department of Assamese, GU, on January 30 and 31.

GUWAHATI, Jan 28: The Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Regional Resource Centre for the North Eastern States branch of National Health Systems Resource Centre organised a regional review programme on the Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA) in NE states here earlier this week.

Dr Veena Dhawan of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare said that PMSMA is aimed at detecting high-risk pregnancies to reduce maternal mortality.

Early-age pregnancies were found in NE states and in this regard the government has taken several initiatives to create awareness among people.

The National Health Systems Resource Centre's Dr Hemanshu Bhushan said that PMSMA is a very important programme, but people's participation is low and hence everyone should work hard and make it a success.

He said the government is organising more media outreach and awareness pro-

grammes among the masses.

Dr Bhushan said that the PMSMA portal is providing the descriptive details about the programme and volunteers can register in the portal service.

The portal is also helping to get the service status and assistance for the future, and grievances can be uploaded in it.

Dignitaries and key stakeholders from Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura took part in the programme, according to a press statement.

Tourism fest Rongali from Feb 3

GUWAHATI, Jan 28: The third edition of the tourism fest 'Rongali' to be held from February 3 to 5, will bring an array of events ranging from ethnic to musical, and from food to adventure sports.

Promoting Assam as a destination for tourism as well as bringing out the traditional best of different communities and tribes of the State, the festival will be held at the Veterinary Ground, Khamapara, and the Brahmaputra riverfront in Guwahati.

The festival is being organised by Trend MMS, a socio-cultural organisation of Assam, which also organises the popular Northeast Festival in New Delhi and Colours of North East in Mumbai.

According to Shyamkumar Mahanta, the chief organiser of 'Rongali', the festival will be among the major festivals of the region with a musical extravaganza for the youths as well as a grand event for showcasing the cultural richness of Assam.

Apart from tourists from across the

country, it would be a great opportunity for even the people of Assam to explore several unknown sides of the State. The brand ambassador of Assam and Bollywood star Priyanka Chopra has also agreed to promote Rongali on various platforms," he added.

Opening new vistas for aero sports in Guwahati, the Rongali festival will focus on several adventurous sports on the Brahmaputra riverfront at Sector 1 in Noonmati area. Ten plots are coming from different parts of the country to popularise Assam as an adventure sports destination.

This apart, *'nau khel'* on the Digboi-pudhuri will be another major attraction. Traditional dance forms, food, music and the way of life of the communities including the Bodos, Misings, Karbis, Dimasas, Titas, Sonowal Kacharis, Singphos, Deurs, Tai Phakes, Thengal Kacharis, Ahoms, Bhatias, etc., will be showcased in the fest by participants from various tribal councils and district administrations. A photography exhibition will

display the major tourist attractions of Assam and the Northeast.

Around 35 colourful dance forms, mask presentation by Samaguri Sattra of Majuli, *Mati Akhara*, the *Kaliya Damian unkiya bhrama* directed by Satyria experts Dr Nirupama Mahanta, Bihu workshop, etc, will also be on offer, apart from promotion of ethnic cuisine.

The festival is also supported by the Government of Assam, Hotel and Restaurant Association of Assam (HRAA) and Tour Operators' Association of Assam, among others.

On the other hand, music lovers would be enthralled by popular singers and rock bands. Indigenous sports of Assam such as wrestling, jahaldi, etc., will also be presented by the State Directorate of Sports. There will be a special show by the Assam Police at the Khamapara ground. Tridib Sharma, one of the main organisers and general secretary of HRAA, said Assam needs a big festival and Rongali is the festival which will make a nationwide impact.
